Bookings

Travel & Parking

Bus

Bus parking is available at Monash Park. Groups can access the Heritage Precinct via the Art Tunnel or by using the pedestrian crossing at the Welsford Street and High Street traffic lights to reach either the rear Heritage Precinct entrance or the main Museum entrance.

Car

Parking near the Heritage Centre, including Monash Park and Aquamoves, is limited. If parking is unavailable in Welsford Street near the main entrance, additional parking is available at the northern and southern ends of Monash Park, as well as behind the Museum.

Arrival & Check-In

School groups can access the Shepparton Heritage Centre through the back entrance via the large gate located at the western end of the fence line on the river side behind the Museum. Entry to the Museum is through the side entrance.

- Students may leave their bags in the undercover area near the back entrance during sessions.

Supervision Requirements

Teachers, Support Staff and accompanying adults are responsible for supervising students throughout the excursion and Museum-led sessions.

Accessibility

We aim to make our programs accessible and inclusive for all students. Please contact us in advance to discuss any specific access and inclusion requirements.

Facilities

Students have access to undercover bag storage areas, toilets within the SHC Facility and the nearby public facilities and parks.
