Travel & Parking

Bus

Bus parking is available at Monash Park. Groups can access the Heritage Precinct via the Art Tunnel or by using the pedestrian crossing at the Welsford Street and High Street traffic lights to reach either the rear Heritage Precinct entrance or the main Museum entrance.

Car

Parking near the Heritage Centre, including Monash Park and Aquamoves, is limited. If metered parking is unavailable in Welsford Street near the main entrance, additional parking is available at the northern and southern ends of Monash Park, as well as behind the Museum.

Arrival & Check-In

Main entry to the Museum is through the front entrance. Large groups with prior agreement can access the Shepparton Heritage Centre through the Back Entrance via the large gate located at the western end of the fence line on the river side behind the Museum.

Duty of Care Expectations

All participants and accompanying adults are responsible for their own wellbeing and conduct throughout the museum-led sessions.
